The Lynden Sculpture Garden offers programs for young people—studio classes, our new Art Drop-In, School's Out Workshops, Tuesdays in the Garden, Homeschool Days—that integrate the sculpture collection with the natural environment to create a unique hands-on experience of art in nature. Studio activities focus on 3D artmaking—though we will also do plenty of painting, drawing and collaging—and an age-appropriate understanding of media, processes and techniques.

WEEKLY ART DROP-IN

Drop in to our studio for informal art exploration. Come for 30 minutes or stay for 2 1/2 hours; visit weekly or stop by when you need an after-school activity; bring a friend or sibling or try it on your own. Each week we'll introduce different materials, processes and themes, and get you started on a project. Watch for occasional outdoor artmaking days, too.
