### FIELD TRIP INFORMATION

Thank you for your interest in the Lynden Sculpture Garden! The Sculpture Garden provides a unique experience of art in nature through its collection of more than 50 monumental sculptures sited in 40 acres of park, lake and woodland. Experienced educators engage students in discussion and inquiry through the Sculpture Garden's collection of 20th-century monumental outdoor sculpture and hands-on studio activities. #### **Availability**

Field Trips at Lynden are designed for groups up to 30. If you have a larger group, please contact us. One adult chaperone per 10 students is required. Field Trips are offered year-round on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays unless otherwise indicated. Be sure to dress appropriately for the weather; students will spend time outdoors during the mini-tour.

## Registration

Advance registration is required for all school group field trips. Availability is limited, and reservations are required at least six to eight weeks in advance of desired date.

#### **Fees**

\$7 per child (there is a \$90 minimum for groups under 15). This includes admission, tour, and all art materials. Adult chaperones are admitted free (limit of 4). \$7/adult after four.

### **Special Needs**

When requesting a trip, please indicate your need for any specialized information or assistance for your students. There are very few paths at the Sculpture Garden. If you have any questions about accessibility, please contact the tour scheduler by e-mail or phone.

The Lynden Sculpture Garden does not have indoor lunch facilities, though visiting groups may enjoy our outdoor picnic area for bagged lunches. Our picnic area is located under a grove of tall pines just off the parking lot with restrooms and a drinking fountain near by. Picnic tables can accommodate up to 80 students at a time. If you are planning to picnic, please check with us prior to your tour to make sure it is operational.

All activities are conducted in English unless otherwise requested. If you would like to request a tour in Spanish, German, French, or American Sign Language, please indicate this at the time of your tour request. Translator availability for these languages is very limited.
